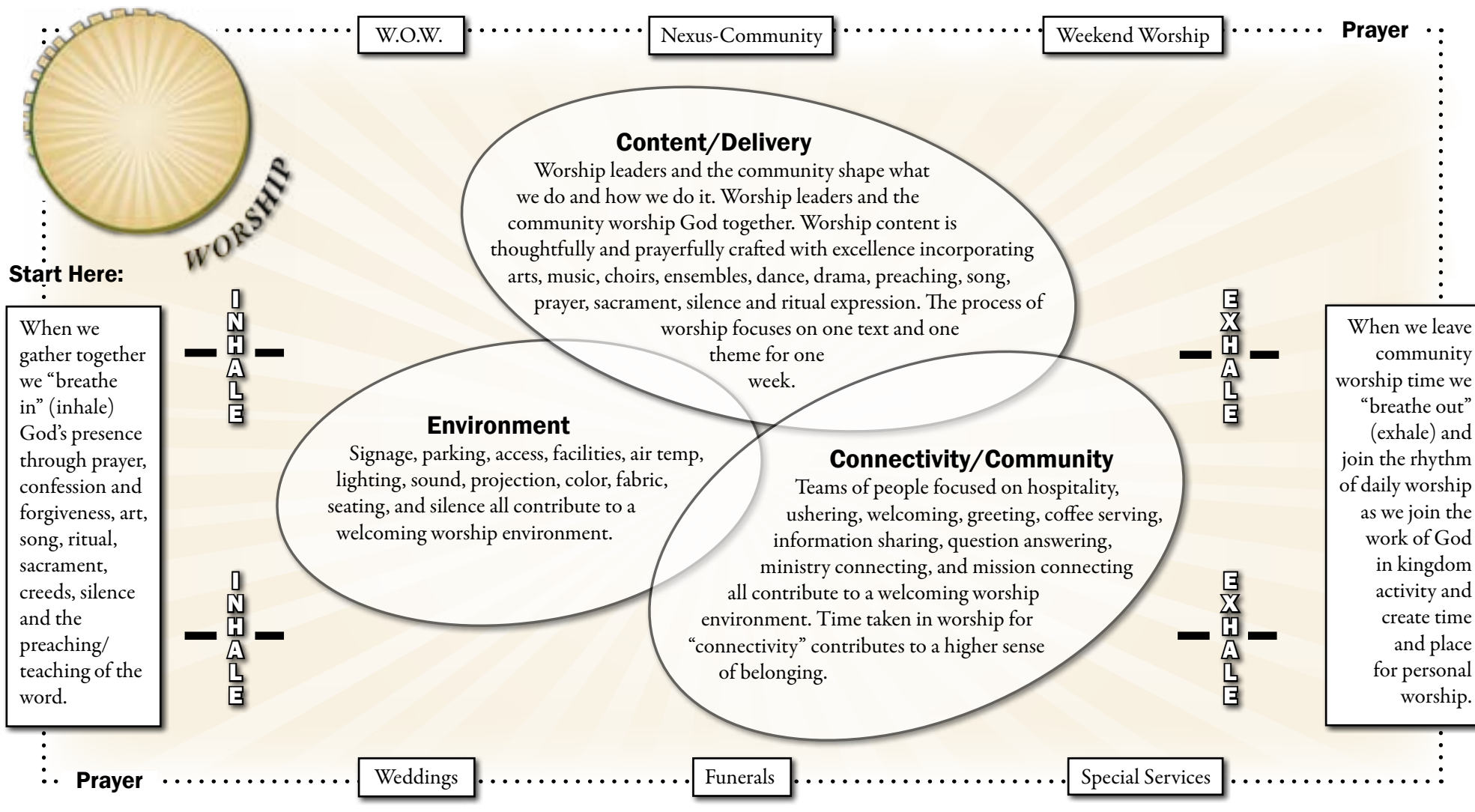


Process Chart

WORSHIP

In the Seasons of Discipleship, worship is the very air we “breathe,” both when the community gathers to worship and when we worship alone or in small groups.



Why Do This?

- God commands us to worship and we want to worship God
- Through inspiring worship we can experience the presence of God
- If worshippers can retain and apply the texts and themes of worship, daily life will be transformed
- The Community becomes the application model for personal daily worship
- When we gather we celebrate the work of God in the world (kingdom) and have a heightened awareness of our place in that work

Measures of Effectiveness:

- Use a systematic survey function to evaluate worship experience
- Employ a conversational evaluation of retention and application
- The transformation in daily behaviors of our people becomes more visible and evident
- The stories and celebrations of kingdom activity are told in worship each week
- There is numerical evidence of increasing attendance in worship and mission activities
